THE WORD IN SONG

It seems an easy response to people who are facing a big decision or difficult circumstance, to say, "The Lord Knows What To Do." "The Lord Knows What to Do" was our song that went to #67 on the Singing News southern gospel chart. It references the story of Paul and Silas in jail. In the face of hopelessness, they still sang a praise to God. They understood their purpose was not to display the worry that consumes the world. They were not to reflect or rehearse the darkness that surrounded them.

There is a power in the fruit of our lips, singing and glorifying God, in the middle of a trial. The second verse explains it like John 10:10- Satan comes to steal! He wants your joy. He wants you to side with him that you are weak, defeated, powerless. He wants the Word out of your mouth! There are "no regrets" for those who continue to speak God's Word, sing His praise, and confess His promises as true regardless of what you see. Satan knows if he can steal your joy, peace, confidence, He can kill and destroy you!

Look what happened- an earthquake shook them all loose! It shook the foundations of the prison. Then their chains became loose. This is not just a story about God's missionaries- it's His Word to YOU! When you continue in what God's promises are to you, in the face of what it may seem, God will shake the foundation of your prison. Your past can no longer hold you! The words of others hold loosen their grip! And you are free to minister life, as Paul did to the jailer. His whole family was filled with joy because God shows up in our faithfulness.
