THE WORD IN SONG

Our new project "Faith Steps Out of the Boat" will be a wonderful declaration of the goodness of God! The title song challenges the listener to remember what God tells us about faith. Everything we believe for and pray for comes by faith. We believe and we speak- that's how we receive salvation. But that's only one dish on the table of God's goodness. He wants us to live His ABUNDANT life. And faith is how we receive EVERY promise of God. In fact, without faith, it's impossible to please Him!

When God gives you a promise, either by an inner witness or by what is written in His Word, we need to declare that promise as ours even when what we see doesn't seem to agree. The song says,

"Though what He asks may seem impossible to do, When the worries of this life are crashing down on you, If you keep your eyes always fixed on Him, It doesn't matter just how big the raging storm you're in, 'cause FAITH STEPS OUT OF THE BOAT!"

It's important to recognize the voice of faith. "Fear listens to the thunder and says, 'You're going under." Fear and faith work the same way. One believes what it sees. The other believes what God says! The one that wins is the one you declare- that's stepping out of the boat! So we need to line up our words to please God:

My faith is not in my ability to make money. My job is not my source of wealth; God is!

My faith is not in the physician who does all he knows to do. Doctors are not my source of healing; God is!

My faith is not in my ability to say all the right words. I am not the Savior; God is!

My faith is not in my children's ability to make all the right decisions. My faith is in the God's ability to reach them!

Faith works by love, so worship the Author of faith- love on Him- then believe that what He has said is true! "STEP ON OUT OF THE BOAT" and declare God's goodness!

his wife took the mic to do the "thank you's" and give-aways. Then through her tears, she related a story that moved us to our core.

Just seven weeks prior to that event, the pastor and his wife had lost their son to a motorcycle accident. He was engaged to be married, and was a fan of old cars- having planned to enter his own in the show that day. He had pulled away from the faith, but was beginning to show signs of returning. He made statements that made his parents wonder if he were ready to come back into fellowship. They were hopeful.

After the accident, as he lay on the side of the road, dying, a believer from another denomination came up to him and prayed with him. Another by-stander who was a nurse and a christian corroborated the story- that he had, indeed, made his heart right with the Lord, just minutes before meeting Him face to face!

In their pain, this pastor's family knew the value of a few words, spoken in passing. Nothing is wasted when you share God's love! We are not guaranteed tomorrow. We are guaranteed that He is with us everywhere we go. Reach out to Him. Share His love. Your few words are seeds that avail much when the Holy Spirit comes along side and waters it!

PARTNERING IN PRAYER & PRAISE

The book of Philippians is a partner letter, much like the one you're reading. Paul commends them for having "shared" and "sent aid" to him. Then he says that "MY God shall supply all YOUR needs..."
