THE WORD IN SONG

In the movie, "The Ten Commandments," it's easy to become mesmerized by the actors. When the children of Israel went across the Red Sea, and Pharoah and his men were drowned behind them, the movie shows a stunned mass. At that point, not only had they seen God move on their behalf by a miracle, and their former slave-master destroyed before their eyes, they also had to realize this was a point of no return. There was no going back. Yet, their trek through the wilderness was marked by murmuring and whining.

Several hundred years later, when God's people are refugees in Babylon, they faced another situation. And then to walk around in the flames and notice one other person there with them-the Son of God... Wow! Talk about honor!

The children of Israel were left in the wilderness for awhile, due to their complaining. They had so many lessons to learn about trusting God. But the three Hebrew children were faithful in their resolve to worship the Lord regardless of ANY circumstance, decree, or proclamation. Even in the face of death, they refused to bow, complain, or whine... and God showed up!

Our song "Take It From Me, Meshach" says when you feel "alone" and "forsaken" and wonder, "Where is the Lord?" remember that God goes where you go. He is there, even when you don't feel Him.
