FROM THE HEART

The Gospels are where you get to know Jesus, and see His heart as He walked the earth. As you read, the impetus that repeatedly emerges is how Jesus loved and was moved by compassion.

In Mark 6, the disciples were physically spent from ministry. Jesus took them to an isolated place for them to rest, only to find the crowds had seen and followed them. They desperately needed rest, but Jesus was deeply moved with compassion because they were like sheep witout a shepherd. He did not condemn, and He could not send them away. Because we do not know the depth of the sin of the people Jesus encountered, we can only conclude that it didn't matter. Regardless of your sin, stage of life, socioeconomic status, or past, you simply cannot exhaust the love of Jesus!

This passage also shows us how we are to love. We are not to qualify who receives love and who does not. We know the Lord is our defense, but He is also theirs! The ground is level at the cross. When Jesus "saw" them, He taught and fed them. We pray to see with eyes of love- God's eyes. Jesus punctuated this in the greatest commandment: LOVE!

THE WORD IN SONG

We recently celebrated Easter, or "Resurrection Sunday," unlike any other in history. Most of us attended a service online, or created a remembrance in our homes. This year was prophesied as a year of great change and surely we have already seen a change beyond what we could've imagined.

In our new song, "A Shakin' and A Rattlin'," we tell the story of Ezekiel prophesying to dry bones. Israel had lost hope, having caused their own nation to fall, and could only see themselves in the past-tense. The future was surely bleak. But God wasn't ready to give up on them. He wanted a witness in the land to His goodness and faithfulness. So, He came to Ezekiel about His plan to restore Israel.

God started by giving the prophet a visual-aid. He had Ezekiel prophesy to dead, dry bones to come together! As the man of God spoke to them, the skeletons began making noise! He continued, in phases, until they, ultimately, resurrected and raised up into an army!

Israel had defiled their land and been scattered, devoid of power. They were dried up skeletons of a nation. But God was ready to restore them. The shaking and rattling that Ezekiel heard was a victory sound! It meant the bones of restoration had begun! In the years to come, the events that built up to the coming of Messiah was a rattling sound proclaiming restoration was coming to the hearts of men! Glory to God!

In Hebrews 12, God promised a shaking that would leave only unshakable things remaining. Recently in our country, God's people have been calling out for healing and restoration. He promised in 2 Chronicles 7:14 that His people, calling out to Him in humility and turning away from sin, would gain the attention of God, and He would heal their land!

This is how it begins: a great change occurs to open our eyes. It's a shaking and rattling- a sign to us that restoration is occuring! God hears! The finished work is yet on the way!
